Based on true events related to the life of up and coming Taiwanese piano prodigy Yu Hsiang (played by himself), TOUCH OF THE LIGHT is a story of inspiration, discovery and love. Born to a rural family in Taiwan unprepared for the birth of a blind son, Yu Hsiang was a curious and precocious child. Touch and sound was everything to him. With his hands, he could feel better than anyone; with his ears and his tape recorder he could hear better than anyone. Taken together with the love of his mother, he had an inner sight and peace that enabled his imagination to soar and he excelled at the piano.
