
Featuring Julianne Moore, Alexander Skarsgård and Steve Coogan, WHAT MAISIE KNEW is a touching comedic drama set against the chaos and complexity of modern marriage and family.

Based on a contemporary interpretation of the classic Henry James novel, and set in present day New York City, the story centers on Maisie, an unwitting seven-year-old girl enmeshed in the bitter divorce of her mother, a rock and roll icon, and her father, a charming but distracted art dealer. As Maisie is shuttled back and forth between them, she comes to rely more and more on her parents' new spouses, who begin to see how selfish and damaged Maisie's parents really are, and who find themselves falling in love with one another.

Julianne Moore stars as SUSANNA, Maisie's mother, and Steve Coogan as BEALE, the father while Alexander Skarsgård stars as LINCOLN, Susanna's new husband and Joanna Vanderham plays MARGO, the former nanny who has become Beale's new wife.



If the parts of a ship are replaced, bit-by bit, is it still the same ship? An unusual photographer, celebrated for her intuitive work, successfully captures the essence of her experience in her photography. However, she also struggles with insecurities over authorship in the context of larger questions about subjectivity and intent in art. An erudite monk, who is an ideologue and practitioner of non-violence, and involved in animal rights activism, is forced to make a choice between death and medicine - medicine that is either derived from, or tested on animals. As death closes in, he re-questions all the ideas that he has always taken for granted. A young stockbroker has a frictional relationship with his grandmother, whom he nurses in a hospital. When it is discovered that a neighbouring patient has had his kidney stolen, he starts out on a trail that leads him to a kidney tourism racket. Altruism and concern leads him to confront the recipient of the kidney, eventually making him discover how intricate morality could be. Following the separate strands of their philosophical journeys, and their eventual convergence, SHIP OF THESEUS explores questions of identity, justice, beauty, meaning and death.



BWAKAW is an award winning, life-affirming, heartwarming, tear-jerker dramatic/comedy that shows that it's never too late to rediscover yourself. Starring veteran Filipino superstar Eddie Garcia as Rene, a cantankerous grumpy aging gay man who has only come out of the closet recently while in his 70's; he lives alone with only the companionship of an affectionate stray dag (Bwakaw) to keep him company. As he goes about his daily life thinking of his mortality and constantly rewriting his will to reallocate his few possessions to his "friends" and dodging the coffin that he bought on sale years earlier that sits in the middle of his rural home, he is compelled to confront his isolation and seek the help and support of others when the dag becomes gravely ill. Garcia delivers the performance of a lifetime.






